



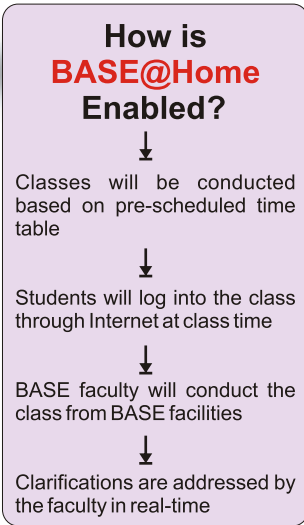

What is NTSE? How Does it Benefit Students?

NTSE (National Talent Search Examination) is conducted for students studying in Class VIII by NCERT to identify talented students. NTSE scholars win recognition as the most promising students of their age group. Students who are awarded these scholarships receive financial assistance up to the Ph.D. level for studies in social sciences, basic sciences and commerce. Those pursuing professional courses such as engineering, medicine, management and law are eligible to receive financial assistance up to the Master's degree level.

The examination is conducted at 2 levels, i.e., State and National. Both these examinations consist of Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) and Mental Abilities Test (MAT). SAT covers the subjects - Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology, History, Civics and Geography. More information on NTSE is available at www.ncert.nic.in



How Does the Preparation Help in Future?

Preparation for NTSE will reinforce the students' subject-specific knowledge and enhance their performance and analytical skills. It also helps in preparation for National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship (NMMS) Examination. NMMS is for students of VIII class, to support them financially for better education and to enhance their talent. Students also get a good foundation to excel in competitive examinations like KVPY, Science Olympiad, IIT-JEE, AIPMT, AIEEE, SAT, CET etc. later on.

Assessment

There are 4 levels at which assessment of student's learning is done:

- **Pre-class:** Synopsis of every chapter is followed by a self-test. A detailed question-wise report of this online test will be generated immediately after the test is submitted.
- **In the class:** A worksheet is administered in the class after a chapter is discussed and the same is evaluated in the class. This is followed by a discussion of the paper.
- **Post-class:** Periodic practice tests on a chapter or a group of chapters will be posted online and the detailed report will be generated immediately.
- **Full length tests:** 5 full length tests will be administered at the end of the course. Each test is followed by discussion of the paper.
